About the *Transactions and Proceedings of the Royal Society of New Zealand*

The Royal Society (known as the New Zealand Institute before 1933) was established in 1847, including the Auckland Institute, the Wellington Philosophical Society and the Canterbury Philosophical Society.

The *Transactions* cover a wide range of subjects. Science has always predominated but the arts and letters were featured in the early days of the publication. By the 1920s the *Transactions* were exclusively devoted to science, particularly zoology and geology.

Contributors to the *Transactions* include James Hector, William Colenso, Charles Fleming, and many others.
